Logan County DUI injury crash

What: Logan County DUI injury crash

Where: 34th St & 71st Ave SE Napoleon, ND (9 miles SE of Napoleon)

When: December 11, 2024 at 10:00 P.M. Central Time

Road Conditions: Gravel roadway

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Driver lost control and ran off the roadway and overturned into creek

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Logan County Sheriff's Office, Wishek Ambulance, Wishek Fire Department

Vehicle No. 1: 2012 Ram 2500

Driver No. 1: Larry Magstadt, 54, Steele, ND - injured

Restraints: unrestrained

Charges: DUI, Failure to give immediate notice

Passenger No. 1: Dustin Moch, 54, Steele, ND - injured

Restraints: unrestrained

Charges: None

Narrative:

Around 10:30PM emergency responders responded to a report of a one vehicle rollover near Beaver Lake State Park. The call was reported by family members of the occupants. Family and emergency responders responded to the area and attempted to locate the occupants. The occupants were located within an hour.

Larry Magstadt reported that he lost control of his vehicle on 71st Ave SE. His vehicle began rotating before leaving the roadway. After leaving the roadway his vehicle fell down the embankment and come to rest facing west on its side in The Beaver Creek.

Both occupants were treated on scene by the Wishek Ambulance. Dustin was treated on scene and was transported to the hospital in Wishek for further care. He received non-life-threatening injuries in the crash.

Larry Magstadt was treated on scene for injuries sustained in the crash. He was not transported. Larry was arrested and charged with DUI and failing to give immediate notice.

The crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol.
