Name Release

What: One vehicle DUI crash

Where: Highway 1 milepost 6 (9 miles southwest of Cooperstown)

When: February 18th, 2024 at 11:06 P.M. Central Time

Road Conditions: Dry asphalt

Weather Conditions: clear skies

Crash Involvement: SUV struck power pole.

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Griggs County Sheriffs Office, Cooperstown Ambulance, Hannaford Fire and Rescue.

Vehicle No. 1: 2019 Chevrolet Traverse

Driver No. 1: Casey Zuck, 36, of Jamestown, ND- injured

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Charges: Driving under the Influence, open container of alcohol, and Care required.

Charges: Driving under the influence Alcohol, Open container, Care-required

Passenger No. 1: Kandace Dwelle, 41, of Jamestown, ND- injured

Restraints: Unrestrained

Charges: Open container

Narrative:

The Chevrolet Traverse was southbound on Highway 1 when the driver, Casey Zunk, lost control leaving the roadway into the west ditch. Casey overcorrected and reentered the roadway crossing over into the east ditch. The vehicle continued a short distance before striking a power pole. The vehicle came to rest facing northwest in a nearby field.

Both Casey and Kandace sustained minor injuries and were treated on scene by the Cooperstown Ambulance. They were transported to the Cooperstown Medical Center for further care and later released.

Casey Zuck was arrested for DUI and cited for open container of alcohol and care required.
