## \*Update\*LaMoure County Injury Crash \*Name release\*

What: Two vehicle injury crash

Where: Intersection of U.S. Highway 281 & Highway 13 in Edgeley

When: February 5th, 2024 at 2:15 P.M. Central Time

**Road Conditions:** wet asphalt **Weather Conditions:** Fog

**Crash Involvement:** Semi struck passenger car in the intersection.

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, LaMoure County Sheriff's Office,

Edgeley Fire & Rescue, LaMoure County Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2003 Freightliner Truck

**Driver No. 1:** Clint Bohr, 34, Alpina, SD (no injuries)

**Restraints:** Seatbelt **Charges:** None

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2017 Chevrolet Cruze

**Driver No. 2:** Janet Wilhelm, 66, of Edgeley, ND (injured)

**Restraints:** Seatbelt

**Charges:** Failed to yield at intersection marked with a stop sign

## **Narrative:**

The Chevrolet Cruze driven by Janet Wilhelm was westbound on Highway 13 approaching the stop sign at the intersection with Highway 281. A 2003 Freightliner, driven by Clint Bohr was southbound on Highway 281. The Chevrolet Cruz entered the intersection and was struck by the southbound Freightliner. The Chevrolet Cruze left the roadway coming to rest facing northeast in the southwest ditch. The Freightliner came to rest along the southbound shoulder of Highway 281.



Janet Wilhelm sustained serious non-life-threatening injuries as a result of the crash. She received care on scene and was transported to the Jamestown Regional Medical Center by the Edgeley Ambulance. She was then transferred to Sanford in Fargo for further care.

Clint Bohr was not hurt in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
