Fargo area semi rollover

What: Injury crash

Where: Interstate 94, mile marker 346, West Fargo

When: July 11, 2024 @ ~10:30 a.m. CT

Road Conditions: Good, dry

Weather Conditions: Sunny

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved NDHP, West Fargo PD, Sanford Ambulance, ND DOT

Vehicle No. 1: 2018 Kenworth cement truck

Driver No. 1: Corey Cook, 49 YOA Male; West Fargo, ND; Minor injuries

Restraints: Restraints in use

Charges: None filed

NARRATIVE: The Kenworth cement truck was traveling eastbound on Interstate 94 just west of the Sheyenne Street interchange. The truck drove over a soft asphalt patch which caused the vehicle to lose control and overturn. The vehicle rolled onto its side blocking the left lane of the interstate and debris spread into both travel lanes. The driver was evaluated on scene by Sanford Ambulance and was not transported. He was wearing his seat belt and only sustained minor injuries. Traffic was slowed and down to one lane for approximately two hours while ND DOT and the tow company cleared the scene and recovered the vehicle.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP. A photo of the truck is attached below.
