Williams County Injury Crash UPDATED TO FATALITY

What: Fatal Crash

Where: Highway 1804 Mile Marker 333, Approximately 2 miles west of Trenton

When: July 8, 2024, 5:05PM CT

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Sunny

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs Side by Side

Type of Crash: Angle

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Williams County Sheriff's Office, Williston Ambulance, Trenton Fire

and First Responders

Vehicle No. 1: 2019 Can Am Defender

Driver No. 1: David Ferrell, 70-Year-Old Male, Williston, ND Fatal

Restraints: Seatbelt Used

Charges: Under Investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 2006 Ford F-150

Driver No. 2: Jesus Jalomo Salas, 27-Year-Old Male, Mexico Not Injured

Restraints: Seatbelt Used

Charges: None

Passenger No. 1: Kedrik Solis, 22-Year-Old Male, Washington Not Injured

Restraints: Seatbelt Used

NARRATIVE: The Can-Am Defender was northbound on 147th Ave NW. The Ford F-150 was eastbound on Hwy 1804 near mm 333. The Can-Am rolled through to stop sign onto Hwy



1804. The Ford attempted to brake but was unable to stop. The Ford struck the Can-Am in the front driver side area. The Can-Am came to rest in the middle of Hwy 1804 facing east. The Ford came to rest in the north ditch facing east. David Ferrell was transported to CHI St. Alexis Hospital in Williston, and then flown to Trinity Hospital in Minot. The driver and passenger in the Ford pickup were not injured. On the evening of July 10, 2024, David Ferrell died of his injuries at Trinity Hospital in Minot.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
