## Two Vehicle Fatal Crash - Fargo - July 4th

What: Two-vehicle fatal crash

Where: Intersection of 25<sup>th</sup> Street South & 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue South - Fargo

When: July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024 @ approximately 10:41 pm

Road, Weather & Light Conditions: Dry roads, cloudy, lighted

**Type of Crash:** Vehicle vs Motorcycle angle crash

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Fargo PD, Fargo FD, Sanford Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2014 Harley Davidson 883 motorcycle **Driver No. 1:** 47 YOA male, Fargo, ND – fatal injuries

**Restraints:** No helmet worn

Charges: N/A

**Passenger**: 19 YOA female, Fargo, ND – injured – no helmet

Vehicle No. 2: 2015 Mazda 3

**Driver No. 2:** 21 YOA female, Fargo, ND - injured

**Restraints:** Restrained **Charges:** None

**Passenger:** 21 YOA female, Fargo, ND – West Fargo, ND – restrained - injured

## NARRATIVE:

On July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024 a two vehicle fatal crash occurred at the intersection of 25<sup>th</sup> St S and 13<sup>th</sup> Ave S in Fargo.

A 2014 Harley Davidson motorcycle being operated by a 47 YOA male was eastbound on 13<sup>th</sup> Ave and entered the intersection with 25<sup>th</sup> St S on a red light.

A Mazda 3 was traveling southbound on 25<sup>th</sup> St S on a green light and was struck by the Harley Davidson in the front right corner of the Mazda.

Both occupants on the Harley Davidson were thrown from the motorcycle. The driver, a 47 YOA male, was pronounced dead on scene. The 19 YOA female passenger was transported to Sanford Hospital in Fargo with life threatening injuries. Neither were wearing a helmet.

The occupants of the Mazda were both transported by Sanford Ambulance to Essentia Hospital in Fargo for non-life threatening injuries.

The names of the involved parties will be released later in day on July  $5^{th}$  or earlier in the day on July  $6^{th}$ .

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
