## **Two Vehicle Fatal Crash – Lisbon – July 9<sup>th</sup>**

**What:** Two-vehicle fatal crash

**Where:** Intersection of Hwy. 32 and Jackson Ave in Lisbon

**When:** July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024 @ approximately 10:25 am

**Road, Weather & Light Conditions:** Dry roads, clear skies

**Type of Crash:** Vehicle vs motor scooter side swipe

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, Lisbon PD, Ransom SO, Lisbon FD, Lisbon Ambulance Service

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2006 Schwinn Graduate motor scooter

**Driver No. 1:** 66 YOA male, Lisbon, ND – fatal injuries

**Restraints:** No helmet worn

**Charges:** N/A

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2024 Peterbilt semi-truck towing a 2019 Hyundai van trailer

**Driver No. 2:** 63 YOA male, Bismarck, ND – no injuries

**Restraints:** Restrained

**Charges:** Crash under investigation

### **NARRATIVE:**

On July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at approximately 10:25 am, a two-vehicle fatal crash occurred on Hwy. 32 at the intersection of Jackson Avenue in Lisbon.

A 2024 Peterbilt semi-truck towing a 2019 Hyundai van trailer was northbound on Hwy. 32 and turning right (east) onto Jackson Avenue. The 2006 Schwinn motor scooter had been following the Peterbilt northbound on Hwy. 32. When the Peterbilt began its right turn, the Schwinn attempted to pass the Peterbilt on the right and ran into the passenger side dual tires on the Peterbilt.

The operator of the Schwinn, a 66 YOA male, was then struck by the Hyundai trailer. He was pronounced dead on scene.

The 63 YOA male driver of the Peterbilt was not injured in the crash.

The names of the involved parties will be released on July 10<sup>th</sup>.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
