Rural Walsh County Single-Vehicle Motorcycle Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: 75th St. NE (Walsh County Road 9); approximately 4 miles east of Edinburg

When: July 9, 2024, at approximately 1:24 PM CDT

Road Conditions: Good, dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single motorcycle

Type of Crash: Non-collision

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Walsh County Sheriff's Office, Edinburg Fire Department, and Park River Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2002 Harley Davidson motorcycle

Driver No. 1: Male; 63 years old; Edmore, ND; serious injuries

Restraints: Helmet worn

NARRATIVE: The Harley Davidson was westbound on 75th St. NE, east of the intersection with 133rd Ave. NE. The operator failed to negotiate a curve in the road and the motorcycle departed the roadway, entered the south ditch, rolled, and came to rest in the bottom of the ditch. The operator was thrown from the motorcycle. The operator was transported to First Care Health Center in Park River by the Park River Ambulance Service and, subsequently, transported to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks due to the severity of the injuries sustained.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
