Single Motorcycle Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: 3400 block Shyenne St, West Fargo ND

When: June 26th, 2024 at 9:29 PM Central

Road Conditions: Good, Clear

Weather Conditions: Partly Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Single Motorcycle

Type of Crash: Overturn

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, West Fargo Police, West Fargo Fire, Sanford Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2016 Indian Motorcycle

Driver No. 1: Male, 33, Fargo, Serious Life-Threatening

Restraints: No Helmet in Use

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE: The 2016 Indian Motorcycle was south on Sheyenne St in the 3400 block and was in lane one. The motorcycle drove over the median curb and entered the grassy median. The motorcycle sideswiped a light pole which caused the motorcycle to overturn onto its side. The driver of the motorcycle was thrown and sustained serious life-threatening injuries. The driver was transported via ambulance to Sanford Hospital. This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol
