Ward County Fatal Train Crash-UPDATE

What: Fatal Crash

Where: Near Colton Avenue & Railway Street North in Burlington ND

When: June 5, 2024 @ approximately 12:45 AM CST

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs Train

Type of Crash: Angle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Burlington Police Department, Ward County Sheriff's Office, Canadian Pacific Railway Police, Burlington Rural Fire Department,

Vehicle No. 1: 2016 Chevrolet Silverado

Driver No. 1: Anthony Faveros, 30-year-old male, Burlington ND, fatal injuries

Restraints: Not in use **Charges:** None

Anthony Faveros was traveling northeast in a gravel lot and attempted to cross the train tracks. The Silverado became stuck on the railroad near the intersection of Colton Avenue and Railway Street North in Burlington ND. A Canadian Pacific train was traveling southeast and struck the Silverado on its driver's side. Faveros was pronounced deceased on scene.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
