Hwy 1 MM 3.5 Motorcycle Injury Crash

What: A motorcycle struck a deer

Where: Hwy. 1 MM 3.5, about 3 miles southwest of Ludden, ND in Dickey County

When: June 7th, 2024 @ approximately 2:35 pm

Road Conditions: Dry, clear skies

Type of Crash: Motorcycle struck a deer

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Dickey County Sheriff's Office, Oakes Fire Department, Oakes Ambulance, Sanford Life Flight

Vehicle No. 1: 1992 Harley Davidson motorcycle
Driver No. 1: Anthony Moser, 61 YOA, Oakes, ND – serious injuries
Restraints: Helmet worn
Charges: None

NARRATIVE:

Moser was northbound on Hwy. 1 near MM 3.5 when he encountered a deer crossing the roadway. Moser was operating a 1992 Harley Davidson motorcycle and struck the deer.

After striking the deer, Moser was separated from the motorcycle and came to rest in the roadway. The motorcycle came to rest on the southbound shoulder with the deer attached to the motorcycle.

Moser was transported to the Oakes Hospital by the Oakes Ambulance, then Sanford Life Flight transported Moser to Sanford Hospital in Fargo. Moser suffered serious injuries in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
