## **Injury Crash Near Jamestown**

**What:** Injury

**Where:** I94 Westbound Mile Marker 253, 3 miles West of Jamestown

**When:** June 7, 08:15 AM Central

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Sunny

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle/Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rear-end

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Stutsman County Sheriff's Department, Jamestown Ambulance, Jamestown Fire Department, Sanford AirMed

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2014 Ram 2500 towing empty gooseneck trailer

**Driver No. 1:** to be named later, 39yo male, injured, Redmond, OR

**Restraints:** Seatbelt, airbag

**Charges:** Under investigation

**Passenger No. 1:** 7yo female, serious injury, Redmond, OR

**Restraints:** Seatbelt, booster seat, airbag

**Vehicle No. 2:** 1994 Freightliner empty straight truck

**Driver No. 2:** Mohamed Ibrahim, 24, not injured, Waite Park, MN

**Restraints:** Seatbelt

**Charges:** Under investigation

### **NARRATIVE:**

The Freightliner was westbound on Interstate 94 in the right (north) lane followed by the Ram. The Ram rear-ended the Freightliner. After impact the Ram ran off the roadway into the north ditch and overturned, coming to final rest in an upright position facing east. The Freightliner

came to final rest facing north in the north ditch. Both occupants of the Ram were transported to the Jamestown Regional Medical Center by Jamestown Ambulance. The 7yo passenger was then transported to Sanford Hospital in Fargo by Sanford AirMed. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
