Cass County injury crash

What: Pedestrian vs. Passenger vehicle

Where: Eastbound 13th Ave S at the I-29 underpass (East of 38th St S)

Narrative:

Andin was eastbound on 13th Ave approaching the underpass in lane 1. The 41yr old female was jay walking north across 13th Ave under I-29. Andin struck the female in lane 1.

Sanford Ambulance arrived on scene and transported the 41yr old female to Sanford in Fargo for further care. The 41yr old female sustained serious life-threatening injuries from the crash.

Andin remained on scene after the crash. He was arrested for an outstanding Cass County warrant for assault.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
