I-29/I-94 Interchange Injury Crash

What: One vehicle injury crash

Where: Northbound I-29 Exit 63 off-ramp to westbound I-94

When: Wednesday, May 8th, 2024 @ approximately 5:49 pm

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear skies

Type of Crash: Vehicle struck a guardrail

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Fargo Fire Department, Sanford Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2018 Chevrolet Camaro
Driver No. 1: 49 YOA male, Fargo, ND – life threatening injuries
Restraints: Restrained & air bag deployment
Charges: None

NARRATIVE:

On May 8th, 2024, at approximately 5:49 pm, a one vehicle injury crash occurred in the Fargo area. The crash occurred on the loop ramp from northbound I-29 to westbound I-94.

A 49 YOA male was driving a 2018 Chevrolet Camaro northbound on I-29. The Chevrolet exited northbound I-29 to travel westbound on I-94. While negotiating the loop ramp, the driver of the Chevrolet lost control and struck the guardrail on the outside shoulder where the I-29 loop ramp merges with westbound I-94.

The collision caused the air bags in the vehicle to deploy. The driver was transported by Sanford Ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Fargo for life threatening injuries.

The northbound I-29 Exit 63 off-ramp was closed for approximately 75 minutes during the crash investigation.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP. The name of the driver will be released on the afternoon of May 9th.
