FATAL CRASH
ND1806 NORTH OF MANDAN

What: Fatal Crash

Where: ND1806 mile marker 78 about 1 mile north of Mandan

When: 12:45pm

Road Conditions: Clear, Dry

Vehicle No. 1: 2014 Chevrolet Cruze

Driver No. 1: 20-year-old male, Bismarck **FATAL INJURIES**

Restraints: Seat belt worn

Vehicle No. 2: 2024 Kenworth Truck Tractor towing empty tank trailer

Driver No. 2: 46-year-old male, Mandan **NOT INJURED**

Restraints: Seat belt worn

Charges: None

NARRATIVE: At about 12:45 pm, on May 9th, 2024, a head-on collision between a semi and a Chevrolet Cruze happened on ND1806 north, near mile marker 78, about 1 mile north of Mandan. The Cruze crossed the center line while traveling north and struck a southbound semi head-on. The driver of the Cruze sustained fatal injuries and was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of the semi was not injured. ND1806 was closed to traffic from 12:45pm

and reopened at 5:30 pm. This crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
