## FATAL CRASH ND1806 NORTH OF MANDAN

What: Fatal Crash

Where: ND1806 mile marker 78 about 1 mile north of Mandan

**When:** 12:45pm

**Road Conditions:** Clear, Dry

**Weather Conditions:** Clear, Sunny, Scattered Clouds

**Crash Involvement:** Semi, Passenger Car

**Type of Crash:** Head-on Collision

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2014 Chevrolet Cruze

**Driver No. 1:** 20-year-old male, Bismarck FATAL INJURIES

**Restraints:** Seat belt worn

Charges: None

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2024 Kenworth Truck Tractor towing empty tank trailer

**Driver No. 2:** 46-year-old male, Mandan NOT INJURED

**Restraints:** Seat belt worn

Charges: None

**NARRATIVE:** At about 12:45 pm, on May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024, a head-on collision between a semi and a Chevrolet Cruze happened on ND1806 north, near mile marker 78, about 1 mile north of Mandan. The Cruze crossed the center line while traveling north and struck a southbound semi head-on. The driver of the Cruze sustained fatal injuries and was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of the semi was not injured. ND1806 was closed to traffic from 12:45pm



and reopened at 5:30 pm. This crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
