What: Injury Crash

Where: Intersection of State Highway 27 and 18, 12 miles north of Wyndmere

When: November 15th, 2024, 6:06 PM Central

NARRATIVE: The Ford Edge was east on Hwy 27 and the Ford F-250 was south on Highway 18. The Ford Edge entered the intersection and the Ford F-250 struck the Edge in a "t-bone" manner on the driver side. Both vehicles entered the east ditch, southeast of the intersection. The F-250 was pulling a small, enclosed trailer and they both rolled. Hwy 18 has the right of way and Highway 27 is posted with a stop sign. All occupants of the Ford Edge were transported via Ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Fargo.
