## **Update-Two Vehicle Injury Crash**

**What:** Injury Crash

**Where:** Intersection of State Highway 27 and 18, 12 miles north of Wyndmere

**When:** November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024, 6:06 PM Central

**Road Conditions:** Dry, Good

**Weather Conditions:** Partly Cloud

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle vs Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Angle ("T-Bone")

**NARRATIVE:** The Ford Edge was east on Hwy 27 and the Ford F-250 was south on Highway 18. The Ford Edge entered the intersection, and the **Edge struck the F-250 in a "t-bone" manner on the passenger side.** Both vehicles entered the east ditch, southeast of the intersection. The F-250 was pulling a small, enclosed trailer and they both rolled. Hwy 18 has the right of way and Highway 27 is posted with a stop sign. All occupants of the Ford Edge were transported via Ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Fargo.
