**What:** Two vehicle injury crash

**Where:** Interstate 29 exit 67

**When:** November 19, 2024 at 10:34 P.M. Central Time

**Road Conditions:** Dark-lighted. Icy roadway

**Weather Conditions:** snow & wind

**Crash Involvement:** Rearend crash

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Fargo PD, Fargo Fire, Sanford Ambulance.

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2023 Ford Maverick

**Driver No. 1:** Mark H. Steinberger, 74, Hillsboro, ND- injured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt

**Passenger No. 1:** Colleen D. Steinberger, 71, Hillsboro, ND- injured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2009 Toyota Highlander

**Driver No. 1:** Joseph M. Senyon, 75, Fargo, ND- uninjured

**Restraints:** Belted and airbag

**Narrative:**

The Toyota was northbound on I-29 approaching the exit for 19<sup>th</sup> Ave. The driver, Joseph Senyon, began slowing to exit. At this time a Ford Maverick, driven by Mark Steinberger, was also northbound following behind. Mark did not react in time and struck the left rear corner of the Toyota. The Ford came to rest in lane 2 facing south. The Toyota came to rest facing north on the east shoulder.

Sanford Ambulance was on scene and treated Mark and Colleen before transporting them to Sanford in Fargo. Both Mark and Colleen sustained minor injuries.

Joseph was uninjured in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
