**UPDATE: Walsh County Motorcycle Injury Crash**

**What:** Injury

**Where:** North Dakota Highway 32, near mile marker 178; approximately 5 miles SW of Fordville

**When:** September 14, 2024; at approximately 7:58 PM CDT

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Clear

**Crash Involvement:** Single Motorcycle

**Type of Crash:** Motorcycle/Deer

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Walsh County Sheriff's Office, Fordville Fire & Rescue, and Park River Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2010 Triumph RS

**Driver No. 1:** George Midboe; Male; 69 years old; Inkster, ND; serious injuries

**Restraints:** Helmet worn

**NARRATIVE:**

The Triumph was northbound on North Dakota Highway 32 when a deer entered the roadway from the west and struck the Triumph. The driver maintained control and the Triumph came to rest in the northbound lane of travel.

The driver was transported by Park River Ambulance Service to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks.
