Two Vehicle Injury Crash - Fargo - September 17th

What: Two-vehicle injury crash

Where: 600 block of 36th St N - Fargo

When: September 17th, 2024 @ approximately 9:49 pm

Road, Weather & Light Conditions: Dry roads, clear, lighted area

Type of Crash: Vehicle vs Motorcycle head-on crash

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Fargo PD, Fargo FD, Sanford Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2022 Harley Davidson RM975 motorcycle

Driver No. 1: 41 YOA male, Fargo, ND – serious, life-threatening injuries

Restraints: No helmet worn

Charges: DUI

Vehicle No. 2: 2003 GMC Sierra

Driver No. 2: 41 YOA male, West Fargo, ND – no injuries

Restraints: Restrained **Charges:** None

NARRATIVE:

On September 17th, 2024, at approximately 9:49 pm a two-vehicle injury crash occurred in Fargo in the 600 block of 36th St N.

The 2022 Harley Davidson motorcycle was northbound on 36th St N and crossed into the southbound lane. After crossing into the southbound lane, the Harley Davidson struck a southbound GMC Sierra in a head-on crash. The GMC had been traveling southbound on 36th St N and was struck in the drivers side front by the Harley Davidson.

The collision caused the motorcycle rider to be thrown from the motorcycle and the rider came to rest in the southbound roadway. The Harley Davidson came to rest in the

southbound roadway on its side and the GMC came to a stop in the southbound roadway, upright.

The driver of the GMC was uninjured. The Harley Davidson rider was transported by Sanford Ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Fargo for serious, life-threatening injuries.

The names of the involved parties will be released on September 19th.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
