**Williams County Fatal Crash**  
**NAME RELEASE**

**What:** Fatality

**Where:** Near intersection of 130<sup>th</sup> Rd NW and 48<sup>th</sup> St NW, approximately 3 miles SE of Williston

**When:** September 25, 2024 10:00 AM CT

**Road Conditions:** Good, Dry

**Weather Conditions:** Clear

**Crash Involvement:** Single Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, Williams County Sheriff's Office, Williston Ambulance Service, Williston Fire Department, Williston Rural Fire Department

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2007 Peterbilt Truck

**Driver No. 1:** Briot Nehring, 29 Year Old Male, Williston, ND Fatal Injuries

**Restraints:** Seatbelt Not In Use

**Charges:** None

**NARRATIVE:** A 2007 Peterbilt truck was northbound on 130<sup>th</sup> Rd NW just north of the intersection of 48<sup>th</sup> St NW. The Peterbilt drove off the roadway right and steered left in attempt to correct back onto the road. The Peterbilt rolled multiple times and came to rest on its top. The driver, Briot Nehring sustained serious, life-threatening injuries and was transported CHI Williston by Williston Ambulance Services. The driver was later flown to Trinity Health in Minot where he succumbed to his injuries. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
