## Williams County CMV Fatal Crash UPDATE

What: Fatal Crash

Where: 69th ST. NW & 140th AVE. NW (approximately 23 miles north of Williston)

When: 7 September 2024 @ approximately 10:53 PM CST

**Road Conditions:** Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: CMV vs. Domesticated Animal

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Williams County Sheriff's Office, Alamo Fire

Department, Williston Fire Department and Grenora Ambulance Service

**Vehicle No. 1:** 1991 Kenworth Straight Truck

**Driver No. 1:** Rodney Miller: 64-year-old male of Williston ND; fatal injuries

**Restraints:** Seatbelt not in use

Charges: None

**NARRATIVE:** On 7 September 2024 at approximately 10:53 PM CST, a 1991 Kenworth Straight Truck was eastbound on 69<sup>th</sup> St. NW and there was a cow in the road. The truck braked and swerved to the left. The truck struck the cow, ran off the road to the north and rolled. The driver was pronounced deceased on scene. The owner of the livestock was identified as Michael Skor.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
