## **Polaris UTV Rollover Injury Crash - Crosby**

What: Polaris UTV Rollover Crash

Where: 1st Ave SE and Main Street, Crosby ND

When: Thursday, April 10, 3:53 PM

**Road Conditions:** Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Divide County Sheriff's Office,

Divide County Ambulance, and Crosby Fire Department

Vehicle No. 1: 2011 Polaris UTV

Driver No. 1: Juvenile female, 12, Kenmare, injured

Restraints: No helmet, seatbelt not in use

**Charges:** Pending

Passenger No. 1: Juvenile female, 13, Crosby, injured

**Restraints:** No helmet, seatbelt not in use

Passenger No. 2: Juvenile female, 13, Crosby, injured

Restraints: No helmet, seatbelt not in use

**NARRATIVE:** At 3:53 PM, a 2011 Polaris UTV (side by side) was turning south from 1st Avenue Southeast onto Main Street in Crosby. As the Polaris UTV was turning south onto Main Street, the driver accelerated and lost control. The Polaris UTV tipped over onto the passenger side while still sliding on the roadway. The driver was ejected. Two juvenile passengers were also injured in the crash. The driver was transported to Trinity Health-Hospital, Minot. Both passengers were transported to St. Lukes Medical Center, Crosby.
