Barnes County Wrong-Way Fatality Crash UPDATE

What: Fatality/Serious Injury

Where: Westbound I94 Mile Marker 278, approximately 2 miles southeast of Eckelson

NARRATIVE:

On Monday, April 14 at 12:58 pm, a Toyota Camry driven by Steven Bell was traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of I-94 at mile marker 278 near Eckelson, when it struck a Chevrolet Traverse head-on. The Toyota came to rest in the median, the Chevrolet came to rest in the westbound driving lanes. Steven Bell was pronounced deceased on scene. Jeffrey Gross, the driver of the Chevrolet Traverse, sustained serious, non life-threatening injuries and



was transported to Mercy Hospital in Valley City and then to Sanford Hospital in Fargo.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
