Fargo Serious Injury Motorcycle Crash UPDATE

What: Injury Crash

Where: 32nd Avenue South in Fargo, westbound near I29 exit

When: April 25, 2025; 2:42 pm CT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear/Sunny

Crash Involvement: Motorcycle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Fargo Police Department, FM Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1 2014 Harley Davidson

Driver No. 1: John Meyer, Male, 67 years old, Fargo, ND, serious injuries

Restraints: Helmet

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: On April 25, 2025, at 2:42 pm, a motorcycle driven by John Meyer, was traveling westbound on 32nd Avenue South in Fargo with the intention of taking the on-ramp to I-29 northbound. The driver failed to negotiate the curve, left the roadway, and entered the west gravel ditch ultimately crashing. The driver sustained serious injuries and was transported via ambulance to a local hospital.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
