## Williams County Injury Crash **UPDATE**

What: Injury Crash – Rollover

Where: ND Highway 50, near mile marker 32

When: August 8, 2025, at approximately 9:38 p.m. CST

**Road Conditions:** Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: One Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Williams County Sheriff's Office, Williams

County Ambulance, Grenora Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1: 2001 BMW 330** 

**Driver No. 1: Justin Babcock**, 34, Wildrose, injured

**Restraints:** No seat belt in use

**Charges:** Driving under the influence – B misdemeanor

**NARRATIVE:** On August 8, 2025, at approximately 9:38 p.m., a 2001 BMW 330 was traveling westbound on ND Highway 50 near mile marker 32 when it failed to negotiate a curve. The vehicle spun, left the roadway, continued west in the ditch, traveled up an embankment, and overturned. The driver, Justin Babcock, was not wearing a seat belt and was ejected from the vehicle. He was transported to CHI St. Alexius in Williston for medical treatment and was later placed under arrest for driving under the influence.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
