NARRATIVE: On August 20, 2025, at approximately 5:55 p.m., a 2005 Harley-Davidson motorcycle was traveling westbound on I-94 in Barnes County when the driver lost control. The motorcycle left the roadway and continued into the median. The driver was not wearing a helmet and sustained fatal injuries. The passenger was not wearing a helmet, suffered injuries, and was transported for medical treatment.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
