## **CASS COUNTY MULTIPLE VEHICLE INJURY CRASH**

**What:** Injury Crash

**Where:** I-94 (eastbound), MM 347

**When:** Tuesday, August 26, 2025, at 8:06 a.m. Central Time

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Good

**Crash Involvement:** Four vehicles

**Type of Crash:** Rear end

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, West Fargo PD, West Fargo Fire, Sanford Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2016 Ford Fusion

**Driver No. 1:** Male, 22, Fargo, not injured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use

**Charges:** Following too close (Moving Violation)

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2019 Chevy Impala

**Driver No. 2:** Male, 70, West Fargo, not injured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use

**Passenger No. 1:** Female, 70, West Fargo, serious injuries

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use

**Vehicle No. 3:** 2018 Ford Explorer

**Driver No. 3:** Male, 28, Moorhead, MN, not injured

**NARRATIVE:** On Tuesday, August 26 at approximately 8:06 AM, a 4-vehicle rear end crash occurred on I-94 eastbound near MM 347. A separate property-only crash on eastbound I-94, MM 349 occurred several minutes before (approximately 8:00 AM) and resulted in slow-to-stopped traffic on I-94 at the time.

A Toyota Tundra, Ford Explorer, and Chevy Impala came to a stop due to traffic in front of them stopping. The driver of a Ford Fusion failed to observe that traffic in front of him was coming to a stop. The Ford Fusion rear-ended the Chevy Impala, pushing the Impala into the Ford Explorer. The Ford Explorer was then pushed into the back of the Toyota Tundra.

The passenger of the Chevy Impala sustained serious injuries and was transported via Sanford ambulance to Sanford Medical Center. None of the other parties involved were injured. The driver of the Ford Fusion was cited for following too close.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
