Walsh County Injury Crash **UPDATE**

What: Injury Crash

Where: North Dakota Highway 17, near mile marker 129; east side of Grafton

When: August 29, 2025; at approximately 7:53 AM CDT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Foggy

Crash Involvement: Vehicle/Vehicle

Type of Crash: Head-on

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Grafton Police

Department, Walsh County Sheriff's Department, Grafton Fire Department,

and Valley Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2024 Ford Escape

Driver No. 1: Ardis Pitcher; 70; Cavalier, ND; serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt worn; airbags deployed

Charges: Under investigation

Passenger No. 1: Randy Collins; 65; Grafton, ND; serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt worn; airbags deployed

Vehicle No. 2: 1992 Ford F150

Driver No. 1: Juvenile driver, non-life-threatening injury

NARRATIVE: The Escape, driven by Ardis Pitcher, was eastbound on ND Highway 17, approaching an eastbound implement of husbandry (a farm tractor pulling a chisel plow) in the lanes of travel. The F150 was westbound on ND Highway 17, in the left lane. Pitcher attempted to overtake the

implement of husbandry in a no passing zone, crossed the centerline, and struck the F150 head-on. At the time of the crash, dense fog was present. Pitcher and passenger, Randy Collins, were transported to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks. The juvenile driver was transported to a local hospital and their name will not be released. The farm implement was not part of the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
