## MOUNTRAIL COUNTY INJURY CRASH UPDATE

What: Serious Injury Crash

Where: US Highway 2, MM 90 (US 2/4th Street SE intersection), Stanley

When: Monday, December 15, 2025, 6:45 AM, central time

**Road Conditions:** Icy

**Weather Conditions:** Dry

Crash Involvement: CMV/ vehicle

Type of Crash: T-bone

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Stanley Police Department, Stanley

Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2014 Peterbilt Semi pulling a water-hauling semi-trailer

**Driver No. 1:** Miguel Gonzalez, 51, Danube, MN, not injured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2012 Subaru Legacy

**Driver No. 2:** Steven Jemtrud, 21, Stanley, serious injury

**Restraints:** Seatbelt not in use

**NARRATIVE:** On Monday, December 15 at approximately 6:45 AM, a 2012 Subaru Legacy driven by Steven Jemtrud, was southbound crossing U.S. Highway 2. Jemtrud crossed the median at 4<sup>th</sup> Street Southeast and continued southbound and was struck by an eastbound 2014 Peterbilt Semi pulling a semi-trailer driven by Miguel Gonzalez. Jemtrud was taken via ambulance to Trinity Hospital, Minot. Gonzalez was not injured.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
