### **LaMoure County Serious Injury Crash**

**What:** Serious Injury

**Where:** Intersection of Hwy 281 and County Road 35

**When:** February 21, 2025, at 5:53PM Central Time

**Weather Conditions:** Seasonal

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle vs vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Side-impact collision/t-bone

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, LaMoure County Sheriff, Jamestown Ambulance, Local Fire Department

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2019 Peterbilt/Trailer

**Driver No. 1:** Male, 47 years old, Jamestown, ND

**NARRATIVE:** On February 21, 2025, at approximately 5:53 PM, a two-vehicle injury crash occurred in LaMoure County at the intersection of Highway 281 and County Road 35. A Ford Bronco traveling eastbound failed to stop at a stop sign, resulting in a T-bone collision with a northbound Peterbilt semi-truck in the northbound lane of Highway 281. The driver of the Bronco, a 38-year-old male from Jamestown, ND, sustained serious injuries in the crash. The driver of the Peterbilt semi-truck, a 47-year-old male from Jamestown, ND, was not injured. This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
