NARRATIVE: At approximately 2:30 AM on February 28, the driver of the Kenworth was driving northbound, entering I-29 and was struck from behind by the cattle hauler. The Kenworth came to rest on the shoulder of the road and the cattle hauler came to rest in the right lane. The driver of the cattle hauler was able to exit the truck prior to it catching fire and becoming engulfed. The driver of the cattle hauler incurred minor injuries and was taken by ambulance to Sanford.

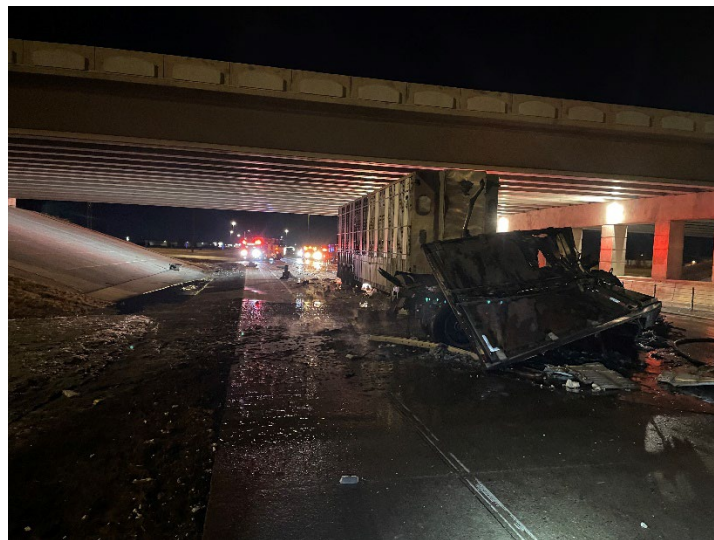
