McHenry County Fatal Crash - UPDATE

What: Vehicle vs. Pedestrian Fatal Crash

Where: 100 Block 42nd St N, approximately 5 miles south of Karlsrue

When: 1/8/2025 approximately 9:05 PM CST

Road Conditions: Wet

Weather Conditions: Rain/snow mix

Crash Involvement: Towed Vehicle vs. Pedestrian

Type of Crash: Non-collision

Agencies Involved: NDHP, McHenry County Sheriff's Office, Velva Ambulance, Trinity First

Vehicle No. 1: 1989 Ford F350

Driver No. 1: Corey Stevens, 64 years old, Voltaire, ND, Fatal

Vehicle No. 1: 2002 GMC Yukon

Driver No. 1: James Ryan, 74 years old, Balfour, ND, Uninjured

Restraints: None

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE: A 1989 Ford F350 being driven by Corey Stevens, from Voltaire, ND attempted to leave a driveway on 42nd St N in rural McHenry County when it went off the driveway and got stuck in a ditch. A 2002 GMC Yukon being driven by James Ryan, from Balfour attempted to tow the Ford out of the ditch. As they were towing the vehicle, they got close to a nearby structure. They stopped to check their progress and Stevens exited his vehicle. Ryan continued to tow the vehicle, not knowing that Stevens had exited. Stevens was then pinned between the Ford and the structure. Stevens was extricated and CPR was performed on scene. Stevens succumbed to his injuries on the way to the hospital.
