Williams County Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: 8150 Block of 151st Ave NW (Williams County Road 5) Approximately 1 mile south of Grenora

When: January 10, 2025 at 09:06 AM CT

Road Conditions: Ice covered

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: CMV vs CMV

Type of Crash: Rear End

NARRATIVE: On January 10, 2025, an injury crash occurred approximately 1 mile south of Grenora on Williams County Road 5. A 2020 Kenworth Semi driven by Anthony Brumfield was driving north on Williams County Road 5 and had slowed down to turn into a disposal site. As Brumfield began making a left hand turn into the disposal site, a 2015 Freightliner service

truck being driven by Hunter McLean was also driving north. McLean came up over the crest of a small hill, saw the Kenworth semi, and began applying the brakes. Due to the extremely icy road conditions, McLean began sliding and struck the rear end of the trailer attached to the Kenworth semi being operated by Brumfield. McLean sustained suspected serious injuries and was transported by Ambulance to CHI St. Alexis Hospital in Williston. Brumfield sustained minor injuries. A small section of Williams County Road 5 was shut down approximately 9 hours while the scene was cleared. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
