## **McLean County Injury Crash**

**What:** Snowmobile Injury Crash

**Where:** Highway 83 & 21<sup>st</sup> ST NW (approximately 7 miles south of Max)

**When:** January 25, 2025 @ 3:30 PM CST

**Road Conditions:** Off-road, snow-covered

**Weather Conditions:** Clear

**Crash Involvement:** Snowmobile

**Type of Crash:** Hit embankment

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, McLean County Sheriff's Office and Garrison-Max Ambulance District

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2015 Polaris 700 RMK snowmobile  
**Driver No. 1:** 21-year-old male of Minot ND (serious injury)  
**Restraints:** Helmet in use  
**Charges:** Under investigation

### **NARRATIVE:**

On January 25, 2025, at approximately 3:30 PM CST, a snowmobile rider was northbound in the west ditch near the intersection of Highway 83 and 21<sup>st</sup> ST NW. The rider hit an embankment and then vaulted off 21<sup>st</sup> ST NW where they crashed. The driver was transported by ambulance to Trinity Hospital.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
