What: Snowmobile Injury Crash

Where: Highway 83 & 21st ST NW (approximately 7 miles south of Max)

When: January 25, 2025 @ 3:30 PM CST

Road Conditions: Off-road, snow-covered

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Snowmobile

Type of Crash: Hit embankment

Driver No. 1:	21-year-old male of Minot ND (serious injury)

NARRATIVE:

On January 25, 2025, at approximately 3:30 PM CST, a snowmobile rider was northbound in the west ditch near the intersection of Highway 83 and 21st ST NW. The rider hit an embankment and then vaulted off 21st ST NW where they crashed. The driver was transported by ambulance to Trinity Hospital.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
