McHenry County Fatal Crash

What: Vehicle vs. Pedestrian Fatal Crash

Where: 100 Block 42nd St N, approximately 5 miles south of Karlsrue

When: 1/8/2025 approximately 9:05 PM CST

Road Conditions: Wet

Weather Conditions: Rain/snow mix

Crash Involvement: Towed Vehicle vs. Pedestrian

Type of Crash: Non-collision

Agencies Involved: NDHP, McHenry County Sheriff's Office, Velva Ambulance, Trinity First

Vehicle No. 1: 1989 Ford F350

Driver No. 1: Male, 64 years old, Voltaire, ND, Fatal

Vehicle No. 1: 2002 GMC Yukon

Driver No. 1: Male, 74 years old, Balfour, ND, Uninjured

Restraints: None

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE: A 1989 Ford F350 being driven by a 64 year old male from Voltaire, ND attempted to leave a driveway on 42nd St N in rural McHenry County when it went off the driveway and got stuck in a ditch. A 2002 GMC Yukon being driven by a 74 year old male from Balfour attempted to tow the Ford out of the ditch. As they were towing the vehicle, they got close to a nearby structure. They stopped to check their progress and the 64 year old male exited his vehicle. The 74 year old male continued to tow the vehicle, not knowing the 64 year old male had exited. The 64 year old male was then pinned between the Ford and



the structure. The 64 year old male was extricated and CPR was performed on scene. The 64 year old male succumbed to his injuries on the way to the hospital.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
