TRAILL COUNTY INTERSTATE 29 INJURY CRASH UPDATE

What: Injury Crash

Where: Interstate 29, MM 95; approximately 3 miles north of Grandin

When: Thursday, July 3, 2025, at approximately 3:30 PM CDT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Good

Crash Involvement: Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Traill County Sheriff's Office, Grandin Fire & Responders, Hillsboro Sanford Ambulance Service, West Traill Ambulance Service, and Agassiz Valley Human Services

Vehicle No. 1: 2017 Ford Transit

Driver No. 1: Andrew Clapp, 34 years old; Arvilla, ND; uninjured Restraints: Seat belt worn Charges: None

Passenger No. 1: Roseanne Clapp; 35 years old; Arvilla, ND, injury **Restraints**: Seat belt worn

Passengers No. 2 through 12: Juveniles ranging from 9 months to 16 years old, non, lifethreatening injuries. **Restraints**: restraints worn

NARRATIVE: On Thursday, July 3 at approximately 3:30 PM, a Ford Transit driven by Andrew Clapp, was southbound on Interstate 29 north of Grandin, traveling in the right lane. The left rear tire blew, and the Ford entered the west ditch, rolled, and came to rest facing



northwest. Injured occupants were transported via ambulance to area medical facilities. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
