Type of Crash: T-bone

Driver No. 1: Male, 15, Williston, seriously injured

NARRATIVE: On July 5, 2025, at approximately 12:38 a.m., a 2025 Kawasaki dirt bike was traveling westbound on 29th Street West. At the same time, a 2007 Dodge Charger, driven by Janyce Gurule, was traveling southbound on 29th Court West. The Dodge Charger

entered the intersection toward a nearby apartment complex parking lot and the dirt bike struck the Dodge Charger in the intersection. The dirt bike rider, a juvenile, was ejected and collided with a parked Ford F-150. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
