NARRATIVE:

On July 7, 2025, at approximately 2:03 p.m., a Hyundai Tucson driven by Michael Callahan, was westbound on U.S. Highway 2. A Freightliner pulling a grain trailer driven by John Fuentes, was northbound on N.D. Highway 32, crossing U.S. Highway 2 onto 1st Avenue in Petersburg, ND. The

Hyundai Tucson struck the right side of the Freightliner and came to rest in the east ditch of 1st Avenue. The Freightliner came to rest in the west ditch of 1st Avenue. Both occupants of the Hyundai were transported from the scene by ambulance.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
