Where: Highway 1806; mile marker 40.5

When: June 9, 2025; 11:40 pm CT

Type of Crash: Single-vehicle rollover

Vehicle No. 1: 2003 Ford Ranger

Driver No. 1: Male, 60, Serious Injury

Restraints: No seatbelt

Charges: Driving under the influence

NARRATIVE: On June 9, 2025, at 11:40 PM, a single-vehicle rollover crash occurred on Highway 1806 at mile marker 40.5 in Morton County. A Ford Ranger was traveling northbound on Highway 1806 when the driver failed to negotiate a curve. The Ford Ranger entered the ditch and rolled onto its roof. The driver sustained serious, life-threatening injuries and was airlifted to Sanford Medical Center in Bismarck by Sanford AirMed.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
