## Morton County Serious Injury Crash UPDATE

What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 1806; mile marker 40.5

**NARRATIVE:** On June 9, 2025, at 11:40 PM, a single-vehicle rollover crash occurred on Highway 1806 at mile marker 40.5 in Morton County. A Ford Ranger driven by Dawson Buckley, was traveling northbound on Highway 1806 when Buckley failed to negotiate a curve. The Ford Ranger entered the ditch and rolled onto its roof. The driver sustained serious, lifethreatening injuries and was airlifted to Sanford Medical Center in Bismarck by Sanford AirMed.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
