What: Two Vehicle Injury Crash

Where: County Road 90/ 40th Street, approximately 2.5 miles south of I-94 exit 97 (Hebron)

When: Wednesday, June 11, 2:46 PM

Crash Involvement: Chevrolet Impala, Chevrolet Silverado

Type of Crash: Head-on

NARRATIVE: On Wednesday, June 11, at approximately 2:46 PM, a 2003 Chevy Impala was traveling north on Morton County Road 90, the driver was checking visibility to pass a vehicle in dusty conditions. A 2003 Chevy Silverado pulling a trailer was traveling south on Morton County Road 90. The Impala hit the Silverado head-on in the southbound lane. Both drivers were transported to Sanford Medical Center-Bismarck. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
