CASS COUNTY INJURY CRASH UPDATE

What: Two vehicle injury crash

Where: Cass County Road 26, ½ mile west of Northern Cass Public School

When: Friday, June 13, 8:00 AM

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Partly Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Hyundai Santa Fe and Toyota RAV4

Type of Crash: Head-on

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Cass County Sheriff's Office, Hunter Fire, Sanford Ambulance Service, Sanford AirMed

Vehicle No. 1: 2013 Hyundai Santa Fe

Driver No. 1: Mckayla Johnson, 41, Fargo, serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use, airbag deployed

Charges: Criminal vehicular injury, Class C – Felony; Possession of a control substance – Methamphetamine, Class A Misdemeanor; Possession of drug paraphernalia, Class C – Felony

Vehicle No. 2: 2024 Toyota RAV4

Driver No. 2: Stacy Satrom, 54, Galesburg, ND, minor injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use, airbag deployed

Charges: None

Passenger No. 1: Juvenile, Hope, ND, serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

NARRATIVE: On Friday, June 13, at approximately 8:00 AM, a Hyundai Santa Fe driven by Mckayla Johnson, was traveling west on Cass County Road 26. Stacy Satrom, driving a 2024 Toyota RAV4, was traveling east on the same road. Johnson crossed into the eastbound lanes

and struck the RAV4. Johnson was seriously injured. Satrom received minor injuries, a juvenile passenger of the RAV4 was seriously injured. All three were transported to Sanford Medical Center-Fargo. The road was closed with traffic detoured for approximately four hours. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
