What: Reckless Driver Pursuit

Where: I-29

Vehicle One: 2010 Nissan Cube

Driver One: Kevin Anderson, 53, Fort Ransom

Charges: Reckless endangerment-extreme indifference (Class C Felony); Aggravated reckless driving (Class A Misdemeanor); Fleeing a police officer (Class C Felony); Preventing Arrest-Resisting (Class C Felony); Failure to maintain single lane/unsafe lane change (Moving Violation); Care Required (Moving Violation); and Failure to use signal (Moving Violation).

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Traill County Sheriff's Office, and Grand Forks County Sheriff's Office

NARRATIVE: At approximately 10:50 AM on June 18, a reckless driver was reported on I-29 northbound in Cass County. The vehicle was reportedly swerving, brake checking, and not allowing others to pass. A North Dakota Highway Patrol Trooper responded and located the vehicle near mile marker (MM) 111 and attempted to initiate a traffic stop. The vehicle failed to stop and continued north and exited at MM 118, then merged back to northbound I-29. At MM 130, law enforcement was able to spike the vehicle and eventually stop the driver. The incident remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
