CASS COUNTY INJURY CRASH

What: Two vehicle injury crash

Where: Cass County Road 26/Highway 18, between Arthur and Hunter

When: Wednesday, June 25; 11:00 AM, Central Time

Road Conditions: Wet

Weather Conditions: Cloudy, light rain

Crash Involvement: CMV hauling gravel and passenger car

Type of Crash: T-bone crash

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Cass County Sheriff's Office, Hunter Fire Department, Arthur Fire

Department, Hunter Ambulance, and Sanford Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2006 Kenworth with a belly-dump gravel trailer

Driver No. 1: Male, 62, San Benito, TX, not injured

Restraints: Seatbelt worn

Charges: None

Vehicle No. 2: 2019 Chevrolet Equinox

Driver No. 1: Male, 74, Beaver Creek, MN, serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt worn, airbag deployed **Charges:** Citation issued for failure to yield

Passenger No. 1: Female, 74, Beaver Creek, MN, serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt worn, airbag deployed

Passenger No. 2: Female, 71, Alexandria, MN, serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt worn, airbag deployed



NARRATIVE: On Wednesday, June 25 at approximately 11:00 AM, a 2006 Kenworth hauling a belly-dump gravel trailer was traveling north on Highway 18. An Chevrolet Equinox was traveling west on County Road 26 and failed to yield to the Kenworth. The driver and passengers of the Chevrolet Equinox suffered serious injuries and were taken to Fargo medical facilities. The driver of the Kenworth was not injured. The driver of the Equinox was cited for failure to yield. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
