CASS COUNTY INJURY CRASH UPDATE

What: Two vehicle injury crash

Where: Cass County Road 26/Highway 18, between Arthur and Hunter

When: Wednesday, June 25; 11:00 AM, Central Time

Road Conditions: Wet

Weather Conditions: Cloudy, light rain

Crash Involvement: CMV hauling gravel and passenger car

Type of Crash: T-bone crash

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Cass County Sheriff's Office, Hunter Fire Department, Arthur Fire

Department, Hunter Ambulance, and Sanford Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2006 Kenworth with a belly-dump gravel trailer Driver No. 1: Ramiro Rios, 62, San Benito, TX, not injured Restraints: Seatbelt worn Charges: None

Vehicle No. 2: 2019 Chevrolet Equinox **Driver No. 1:** Dale Bosch, 74, Beaver Creek, MN, serious injuries Restraints: Seatbelt worn, airbag deployed Charges: Citation issued for failure to yield

Passenger No. 1: Karen Bosch, 74, Beaver Creek, MN, serious injuries Restraints: Seatbelt worn, airbag deployed

Passenger No. 2: Suzanne Sudmeier, 71, Alexandria, MN, serious injuries Restraints: Seatbelt worn, airbag deployed



NARRATIVE: On Wednesday, June 25 at approximately 11:00 AM, a 2006 Kenworth, driven by Ramiro Rios, was hauling a belly-dump gravel trailer traveling north on Highway 18. An Chevrolet Equinox, driven by Dale Bosch, was traveling west on County Road 26 and failed to yield to the Kenworth. Dale Bosch and passengers, Karen Bosch and Suzanne Sudmeier, suffered serious injuries and were taken to Fargo medical facilities. Rios was not injured. Bosch was cited for failure to yield. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
