What: Injury crash involving a law enforcement vehicle

Where: Highway 8, MM 193, 3 miles south of Bowbells

When: Friday, June 27; 3:07 PM, Central Time

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Partly Sunny

Crash Involvement: Pickup, bicycle

Type of Crash: Sideswipe

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Burke County Sheriff's Office, Bowbells Fire Department, Bowbells

NARRATIVE: On Friday June 27, 2025, at approximately 3:07 pm, a Burke County Deputy was driving a marked patrol car south on Highway 8 near mile marker 193, three miles south of Bowbells. A bicyclist was riding south on the fog line on Highway 8. The Deputy moved to the left but struck the bicyclist. The bicycle rider was seriously injured and transported to Trinity Health, Minot by the Bowbells Ambulance. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
