## **Fleeing, Potentially Dangerous Suspects-Morton County UPDATE**

**UPDATE:** At approximately 4:32 PM on June 2, two of the individuals were apprehended in rural Morton County without incident; at 5:10 PM, the third individual was apprehended in rural Morton County without incident.

The names of the individuals and charges:

- Ceejay Siers, 26, Mandaree; Aggravated reckless driving; Refusal to halt; Fleeing a police officer; and Possession of a controlled substance
- Natiala Raine Eagle, 25, Mandaree; Possession of a controlled substance; and Refusal to halt
- David Wayne Warrick, 41, Mandan; Refusal to halt; Possession of a controlled substance; and Tampering with evidence

**NARRATIVE:** On June 2, 2025, at approximately 10:38 am, the Sioux County Sheriff's Department pursued a vehicle from Sioux County into Morton County along Highway 6. NDHP Troopers and Morton County Sheriff's Deputies responded to assist with the pursuit. NDHP Troopers took over primary of the pursuit as the vehicle continued to flee along rural Morton County roads and off road to evade law enforcement. The NDHP Aircraft also monitored the pursuit. The vehicle came to a stop in the area of 44<sup>th</sup> Street and 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Morton County where three occupants fled on foot. This area is along the Heart River, west/southwest of Mandan. Officers searched the area on foot and by air but were not able to locate the suspects and ultimately discontinued the search.

**If anyone observes the suspects, do not approach and call 911.**

Vehicle description: 2012 Chevrolet Avalanche

Suspect descriptions:

- 1 male wearing a brown shirt
- 1 male wearing a red shirt or shirtless
- 1 female wearing white shirt and black pants
